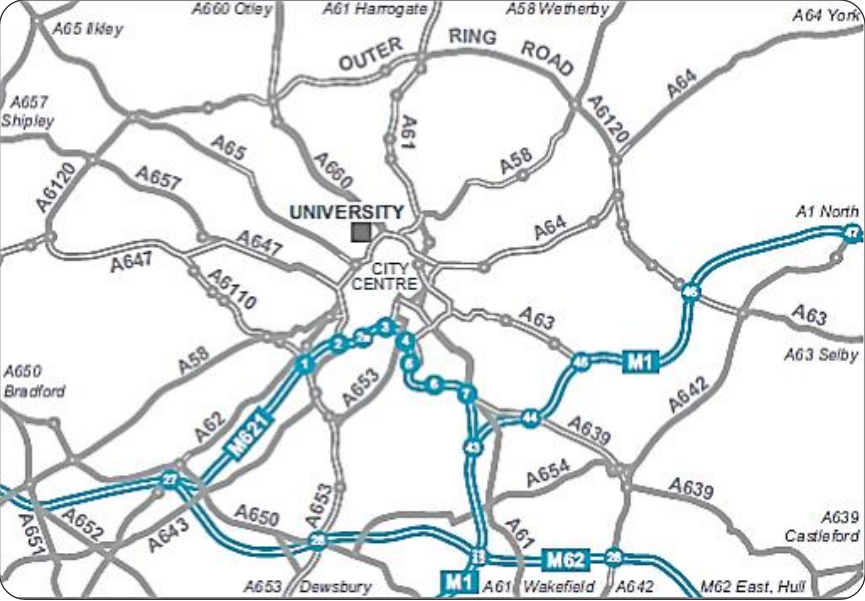
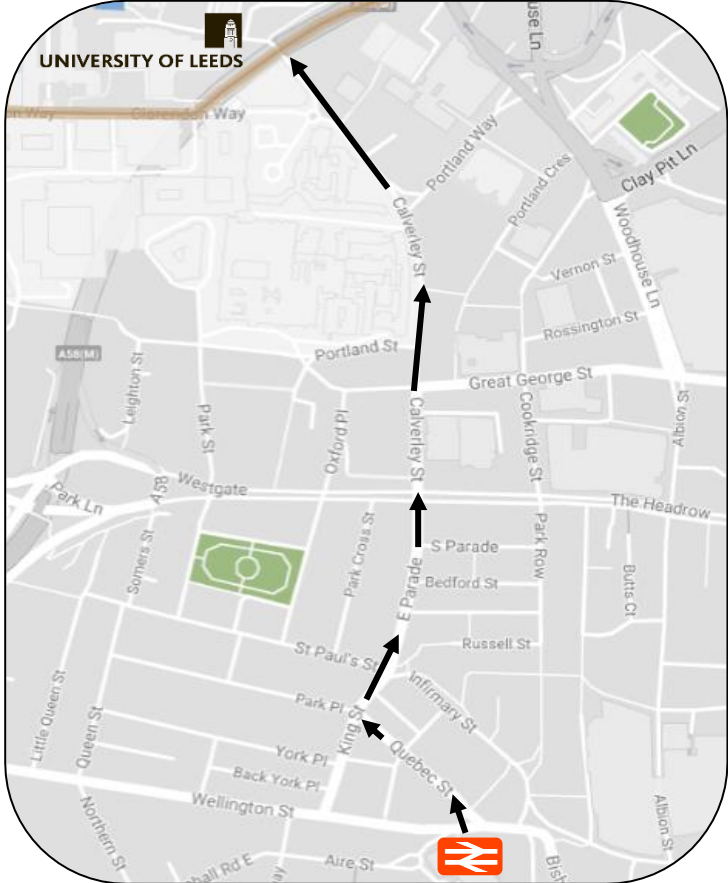

**HOW TO FIND THE UNIVERSITY:** Full details on how to find the University of Leeds are available at [http://www.leeds.ac.uk/info/5000/about/131/find\\_us](http://www.leeds.ac.uk/info/5000/about/131/find_us)

**BY TRAIN:** The University campus is a pleasant 20 minute walk from Leeds city train station. Just follow the directions below and you'll be with us in no time at all.

Come out of the station into City square; with the Queens Hotel behind you, turn left up Quebec Street then right on to King Street. Continue straight onto East Parade and follow it until the first major junction. Cross straight over The Headrow.

Continue up Calverley Street passing the LGI hospital on your left and the Civic Hall on your right. Once you reach the Willow Terrace Road Entrance to the University refer to the campus map overleaf.



**BY AIR:** Leeds is served by two major airports: [Leeds Bradford](#) and [Manchester](#)

Leeds Bradford airport is approximately seven miles away from the University, so easily commutable by taxi.

**BY CAR:** If you are using satellite navigation the address for the entrance to the university multi-storey car park is:

University of Leeds, Willow Terrace Road, Leeds LS2 9JT

More general directions of how to find the university by car are provided below.

**FROM THE NORTH via A1**  
 Leave the A1 at the Ferrybridge services, to join the M62 westbound. Exit the M62 at junction 29 to join the M1 northbound. From the M1 follow signs for the M621 (Leeds City Centre)

**FROM THE SOUTH via M1**  
 From the M1 follow signs for the M621 (Leeds City Centre)

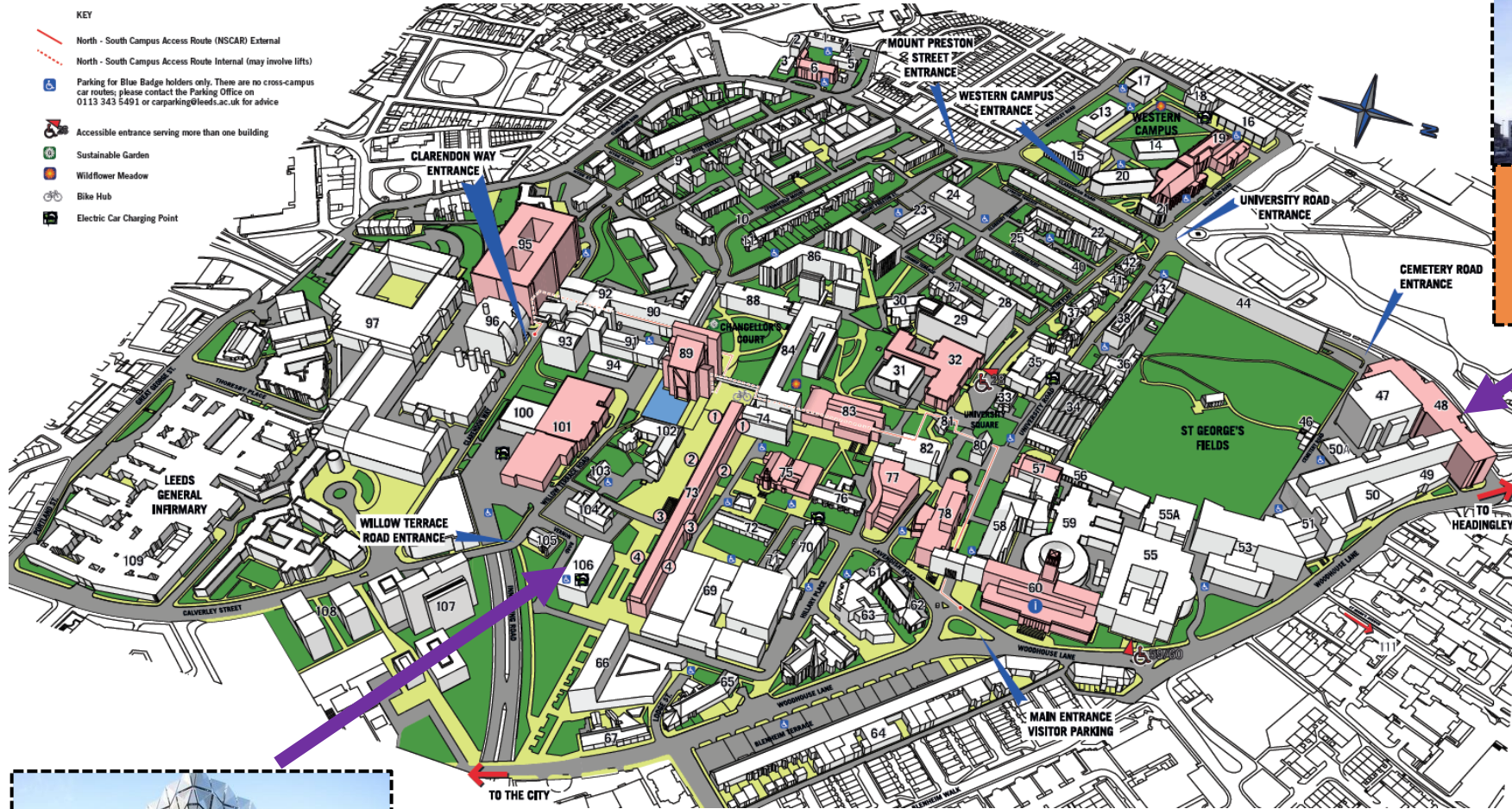
**FROM THE EAST via M62**  
 At junction 29 of the M62 turn onto the M1 north. From the M1 follow signs for the M621 (Leeds City Centre)

**FROM THE WEST via M62**  
 Exit the M62 at junction 27 signposted Leeds M621

- Exit the M621 at junction 2, signposted A643 Wetherby (A58) (Please note: do not take junction 2A)
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit, signposted City Centre Wetherby A643 (A58)
- After leaving the roundabout, stay in the middle or right hand lane following signs for City Centre A58
- After 1 mile, take the exit marked Skipton A660, Universities

**PARKING INFORMATION:** To avoid disappointment, visitor car parking on campus must be pre-booked by a University staff member.

ANPR cameras will be used to verify your booking so that your parking entry and exit are automated so don't forget to send your host your registration plate!

We would recommend using the multi-storey car park which is a 10 minute walk away from the School of Chemical and Process Engineering and accessed by the Willow Terrace Road Entrance.
